Fish and No Coastal Wind Farm groups attended the Port Stephens
Councillors meeting held on Tuesday 24th October in support of Councillor
Chris Doohan's notice of motion. The notice of motion which was carried
consisted of

- 1. That PSC acknowledges the Cira 2,000 people that rallied against a Port Stephens Offshore Wind Power Zone on Saturday 7th October 2023
- 2. That council opposes the issuing of any exploration licenses for the proposed offshore wind power zones.
- 3. The council supports local efforts by community groups seeking to stop the offshore wind power zones.
- **4.** That council writes to Minister Chris Bowen seeking a moratorium on any currently unapproved offshore wind power zones.
- 5. That Council write to Federal Labor MP Meryl Swanson and State Labor MP Kate Washington to secure their support for the opposition to the offshore wind power zone and ask for a response confirming or rejecting support by 3rd November and if rejecting, state reason why.





• 29/10/23 - Paddle Out Against the Offshore Wind Farms

The surfing community, concerned residents, tourism operators and small business owners from Port Stephens gathered on One Mile Beach to express their concerns about the proposed installation of a wind farm in our beloved coastal community. The event brought together locals who are passionate about preserving the natural beauty and unique character of our shoreline whilst protecting the vast array of wildlife.

The event provided a platform to show unity in numbers against the proposed wind farms, with over 120 surfers and 350+ beachgoers forming a whale tail on the shores of One Mile Beach. The event coincided with a Paddle Out and Rally held in the Illawarra, which had a huge turnout of over 2000 people, plus the 220+ surfers in the Paddle Out
